How we help

Our financial assistance helps to cover costs, such as: rent, gas, groceries, utility bills, hospital parking, broviac supplies, medical expenses, and ambulance bills.

Our foundation interacts directly with the service providers (such as utility companies or landlords), to ensure that the bills are paid on time. This provides some relief to parents, freeing up time so they can focus on their child beating cancer.

How are donations distributed?

We work closely with Social Workers at the Alberta Children's Hospital. They identify cancer families who align with the support that our Care Program offers, and reach out to us on their behalf. We work with them to determine each family's specific need, then whenever possible, pay bills directly on the family's behalf - eliminating one more stress.
